



Contest Rules

1. All 106.9 The Bull contests are open to all 106.9 WZZS listeners unless specific age is required by type of contest, participating agency or advertiser or by law.
2. Only one (1) qualifier or winner per family and household within a 30 day period.
3. Winners may be required to sign a release, and all winners agree to allow 106.9 The Bull to use their name, and/or likeness for promotional purposes without further compensation. All calls coming in to 106.9 WZZS are taped and may be aired on 106.9 WZZS without further approval.
4. 106.9 WZZS is not responsible for problems occurring within the telephone system which either inhibit or increase the chances of winning a phone-in contest. In the event two or more phone lines are "tie together" during a phone-in contest, the entire call & all callers "tied together" will be disqualified and another caller will be taken. 106.9 WZZS cannot award duplicate prizes to all parties in a "tied-together" situation. In case of telephone line malfunctions, the decision of 106.9 WZZS will be final.
5. Employees and agents of Heartland Broadcasting and their families, their advertising agencies, or representatives are ineligible to enter contests.
6. Winners may not request substitution or other consideration from the originally awarded prize. Unless otherwise stated, all prizes are to be picked up from the WZZS business office or specified location where contest is held.
7. Prizes are non-transferable. Prizes have no cash value, expressed or implied.
8. 106.9 The Bull reserves the right to revoke prizes if the winner does not meet any or all eligibility requirements, even though an announcement may have been made on the air indicating that person as the winner.
9. A 1099 MISC form will be completed and filed with the Internal Revenue Service for each winner who over the course of the calendar year has won prizes with a total value of \$600 or more. All local, state and federal taxes are the sole responsibility of the winner.
10. WZZS may, due to the unavailability of prizes awarded, substitute another prize of equal or greater value for the prize originally won. WZZS will not be responsible, or be held liable for prizes awarded to an event that is canceled due to circumstances beyond our control.
11. With respect to any disputes regarding contests, the decision of WZZS is final.
12. WZZS, it's agency, and representatives shall not be liable for any claim, injury or damage from any WZZS contest or prize awarded in a contest.
13. All contest entries become the property of WZZS. 106.9 The Bull may withhold any or all contest materials, for any reason, station management deems crucial to the completion of the contest, or for any reason relating to publicity and/or advertising.
14. Unless otherwise stated, multiple entries by the same person will be discarded and may be deemed cause for disqualification.
15. Employees with other Radio Broadcasting companies are not eligible to win contests on 106.9 The Bull.
